With reference to your letter of the 12th instant, respecting the wood motor vessel "CALARABIA 11" now renamed "CALTANURA", Ipswich Report No. 106084. I have to report that the pumping arrangements are satisfactory and the engines have been examined under working conditions.

The size of the intermediate shaft as fitted in the vessel is $2\frac{3}{4}$ " diameter and the following particulars are added for your information.

- Diameter and stroke of bilge pump - $2\frac{3}{8}$ " by $1\frac{1}{4}$ " at half engine speed.
- Capacity of lubricating oil pump - 22 pints per minute.
- Thickness of cylinder liners - .421".
