H. Dear Sir,

I beg to acquaint you that the Owners of the steamer "COMBO" have informed the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux that they are communicating with their Gambia Office in regard to the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys which became due at the end of September and December last respectively.

It is observed that the previous surveys of this vessel have been carried out at Dakar, and in the event of the Owners deciding to have the above inspections held at this port the Committee will be glad if you will be good enough to appoint a competent and independent surveyor to carry them out upon your receiving a request from the Owners, or their Representatives, to do so.

A form for reporting the survey is enclosed which should be returned to this Office in due course, and I may say that all fees and expenses in connexion with the matter must be paid by the Owners, or their Representatives, and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
