Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp report that the steamer "PARAMÉ" ex "SIERRA NEGRA" had been surveyed in drydock at that port and some repairs effected. A new ash shoot, however, requires to be made watertight and its lid refitted.

The Boiler Survey has also been partly held at Antwerp, and to complete the same and entitle the vessel to the record B.S. 7, 25 the safety valves require to be adjusted.

It is stated that these matters will be attended to at Havre, whither the vessel has proceeded, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will attend to the case accordingly.


