The Antwerp Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, 2 shell plates renewed and shell plating and framing faired as necessary.

A new ash shoot requires to be made watertight and its lid refitted and it is stated this will be done at Havre to which port the vessel is proceeding.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 7-25, subject to the ash shoot being dealt with as recommended.
