Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 6th ultimo respecting the "Sierra Morena", I beg to inform you that Messrs. Credit Foncier d'Algerie et de Tunisie, state they are unable for the present to advise this Society as to their intention respecting the boiler survey.

They explain that they do not intend to keep this vessel and they are arranging to find a Purchaser or a Manager.

Meantime this vessel is laid up in the port of Antwerp as well as the other "Sierra" vessels. They still retain their Belgium flag.

The Owners state that they expect that the question of Ownership will be settled in a short time and that we shall be advised in due time of the name of the new Owner if sold, or of their intention respecting the boiler survey if the vessel definitively remains their property.
