On March 10th and subsequent dates the vessel then lying afloat at the Bethlehem Steel Co., Key Highway, Baltimore, Md., the undermentioned cargo derricks were subjected to the test loads as shown.

- Ten three-ton electric crane booms tested to 8400 lbs.
- One eight-ton cargo boom tested to 23000 lbs.
- One thirty-five ton cargo boom tested to 90000 lbs.

These tests were carried out to the satisfaction of the undersigned as regards the stresses imposed by the test loads stated above.
