I return herewith the sketch, forwarded with Mr. Ward's letter of the 18th instant, showing the proposed method of fitting vertical sparring between frames in Nos. 2, 3 & 4 holds of the S.S. No. 842 now being built by Messrs. W. Gray & Co., and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the Builders' proposal will be approved, subject to the following notation being made in the Register Book, viz;- "Cargo battens between frames in Nos. 2, 3 & 4 holds only", as was approved in the case of the steamers "CITY OF NORWICH" and "KATHLAMBA" by the General Committee on the 8th May last.

The approved plans forwarded for reference are also enclosed.
