In the case of the "OCHTA", the Special Survey No.3 became due in November, 1932, and the Boiler Survey in March last.

In the case of the "OKA" the Boiler Survey became due in July and the 2nd Special Survey No.1 in September last.

Enquiries have been addressed to the Owners from time to time, in each case, but no reply has been received.

On the 7th ultimo a letter was addressed to the Owners regarding both vessels informing them that the Committee had deferred the further consideration of the cases for one month, but that in the absence of a reply within that time, the Committee would have no option but to expunge the vessels' Classes with a Red Line.

Up to the present no reply has been received to this communication.

The year of grace in the case of the "OCHTA" expired last month.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 8th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessels' characters to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (12,33), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, as indicated in their letter of the 7th ultimo.
