Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamers "OCHTA" and "OKA", I have to refer you to my letter of the 7th ultimo stating the Committee's decision to defer dealing with these vessels' classes for a further month to enable you to reply to the several enquiries which have been addressed to you from time to time regarding the surveys which are overdue.

As this time has now elapsed and I have received no information from you regarding the matter, the Committee, who have had the cases before them at their meeting today, regret they have had no alternative but to give instructions that the class of each vessel to be expunged from the Register with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
