Inquiries in regard to the above surveys were addressed to the Owners from time to time without eliciting a reply, and on the 5th September they were informed that unless their confirmation was received by return mail it would be reported to the Committee that it was not their intention to retain the class of this vessel. No reply was received to this communication, and on the 7th ultimo the Owners were informed that the Committee had deferred further consideration of the case for one month, but that in the absence of any information from them within that time the Committee would have no option but to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a Red Line. No reply to this communication has been received from the Owners.
