Dear Mr. French,

I am enclosing a letter dated November 23rd, from the Barge & Ferry Service of the Canadian National Railways, from which you will note that they have withdrawn their fleet of tugs and barges from class.

I understand they have also withdrawn their other tug from the B.C. Class.

As you know the Canadian Government Steamboat Inspectors make an annual survey of engines and boilers throughout.

The Canadian Government inspectors' interest in the hull is quite nominal, except for life saving, but the duplication of surveys and fees induces Owners to withdraw from class.
