With reference to your letter of the 9th inst, regarding the first entry report No. 10673 on S.S. "MOUNTPARK", I beg to inform you that the upper and bridge deck plating are increased in way of openings as approved.

The thickness of A to F shell plating and at after end of fo'castle sides are as approved.


The width and riveting of seams G and H are as on approved shell plan. The rivets in quadruple and treble riveted shell butts $4 \times 3 \frac{1}{8}$ diams apart and the spacing of frame rivets 7 diameters.

I much regret these errors in the report.
