Dear Sirs,

M. With reference to your First Entry Report No. 10573 on the S.S. "MOUNTPARK", I shall be glad if you will be good enough to state whether the upper and bridge deck plating is increased in way of openings as approved: the thicknesses of "A" to "F" strakes of shell plating at the after end and of the forecastle sides are as approved and not as stated: the widths and riveting of the seams of "G" & "H" strake are <sup>as</sup> shown on the approved shell plan: the spacing of the rivets in the quadruple and treble riveted shell butts is 4 and  $5\frac{1}{2}$  diameters respectively, and the spacing of the frame rivets 7 diameters and not as stated by you.
