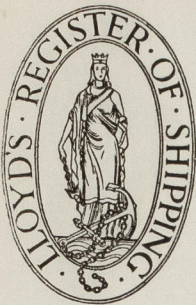


LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

 purpose of ascertaining that she is in a satisfactory condition for
 one voyage in a light condition from Malta to Naples,

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of
 Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by
 me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am
 Recommending ~~that she be~~ that the record of "Surveys Overdue 10/57"
 be continued in the supplement to the Register Book.

From examinations now made, I am of the opinion that the
 Vessel is in a satisfactory condition to proceed in a light condition
 from this port to Naples. It being understood that the ship's class
 will be in temporary suspension during the voyage from Malta to Naples.
