## Motorship "BRITANNIA"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 5th instant and confirm the telephone conversation with you when you stated that it is an Interim Certificate which you require, not Load Line Certificate as indicated in the first paragraph of your letter.

To enable a Certificate to be issued for the ship to proceed on the proposed voyage it will be necessary for an examination to be carried out by the Society's Surveyor and the vessel found or placed in satisfactory condition. As regards the machinery, this will require to be tested under working conditions and the pumping arrangements tested for efficiency. The Certificate issued will indicate that the class of the ship is temporarily suspended during the voyage.
