Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 29th December last respecting the surveys carried out by you in conjunction with Mr. J. D. Sutherst from Genoa, on the s.s. "SNOWDEN SMITH", m.s. "BRITANNIA" and Motor Yacht "NONETA", and have to inform you that your proposed hull fees and expenses for the "SNOWDEN SMITH" and "BRITANNIA" are concurred in.

With regard to the "NONETA", it is considered that fees for yacht surveys in Malta should be calculated on the basis of the U.K. yacht scale (Notice No. 1975 (Y-1957)), plus 50%. This would give a hull fee of £41 5s. Od. of which 50% should be credited to the Genoa Office for Mr. Sutherst's services.

The details of the fees to be charged and the amounts due to Genoa for the three ships dealt with are as follows:-
