With reference to the cables supplied to the s.s. "Warcuta" I beg to state that 30 fathoms of cable as per certificate No. ~~28809~~²¹⁹⁴⁹ was placed on board this vessel as per my report No. 2759. The particulars are as follows :-

Certificate No. 21949, Cabledia. 1-13/16", Breaking strain - 82 3/4 tons, Tensil Strain 59 1/8 tons, Cardiff, 14/11/19.

The other 3 lengths were placed on board and the certificate endorsed by Mr. Graham. This was only mentioned by me to show that the cables were complete. 30 fathoms only were put on board at this port.
