With reference to your letter of the 26th ultimo, regarding the above vessel we have to say that we have been in communication with the Owners - Messrs Compagnia Italiana Transatlantica - of this vessel, who state that they do not wish to continue the classification of the vessel with this Society.

At the same time we have to forward herewith - together with free translation - a letter of the 19th February last with regard to the s.s. "RODI" now "RODI S" belonging to the same Owners as the "ROSIGNANO", from which it will be seen that it is proposed to discontinue the classification of this vessel also with this Society.

These vessels which appear to be sister vessels, are now intended, it is understood, for the Mediterranean trade.

We would say that we have been in touch with the Owners with regard to the case of the s.s. "RODI S" and their enclosed letter of 19th February last was first withdrawn by them for reconsideration.

A final decision has now however been arrived to discontinue the classification of the "RODI S" with this Society and on

enquiries being made regarding the s.s. "ROSIGNANO" we were informed that a similar decision had been arrived at in the case of this vessel also.

When Messrs Compagnia Italiana Trasatlantica first decided to commence structural alterations on the s.s. "RODI S" plans showing proposed alterations were approved and several visits were paid to the vessel at this Port after the work of alterations was commenced.

A copy of this letter and of the Owners' letter of 19th February last has been forwarded to Mr. Turnbull, the Society's Principal Surveyor for Italy.
