PROPOSED STRUCTURAL ALTERATIONS

Dear Sir,

We have to forward herewith blue print plans of midship section and part profile and deck as approved in this office for the proposed alterations to the superstructures of the above vessel, which is at present at this port.

The vessel, which was built in 1918, now has a raised Quarter Deck, Bridge and Forecastle, and is at present classed * 100 A.I. in the Society's Register Book.

The proposed structural alterations consist in filling in the fore well. The existing Bridge and Forecastle will thus be made one continuous superstructure with hatchways of dimensions as indicated on the plans.

The new Owners, Messrs **COMPAGNIA ITALIANA TRANS-ATLANTICA - Genoa**, and the firm charged with the repairs have brought the plans to this office, and these plans have been discussed with them.

As the matter was very urgent the plans had to

be dealt with promptly to meet the wishes of the Owners, who desire to have the work of alteration commenced immediately.

The Owners do not wish any increased draught on account of the increase in length of superstructures now proposed.

Would you please inform us with regard to the following points:-

- 1) Whether the fore peak bulkhead should now extend watertight to the Weather Deck B.
- 2) As we do not have copies of the vessel as originally built at this Office, we shall be glad to be informed whether equipment will remain the same as at present (as desired by the Owners) FOR THE FIGURE 1.
- 3) Whether these proposed structural alterations will involve any change from the present class of the vessel in the Register Book.

Arrangements have been made regarding the testing of the material to be used.
