With further reference to your cable gram of the 22nd February regarding the Steamer "CONCHITA", I have to inform you that this ship was under survey at Cadiz in July, 1959, for damage, docking and annual freeboard surveys. The fees and expenses amounted to Pts. 7,240. Repeated attempts have been made to secure payment but these have not been successful and in August, 1962, the Committee gave instructions for a notation to be recorded against the ship's name in the Register Book indicating that the class had been withdrawn.

In these circumstances you should not issue any certificates or endorse any existing certificates until full payment of this old account has been received, together with the fees for the survey now proposed for reclassification.
