The Boiler Survey became due 8.28 but in reply to the usual notice the Owners stated that, in their opinion, the survey should not be due until 12.28 as the vessel was last examined at Greenock in December 1927.

It was explained to them by letter that as the boiler was last surveyed in 8.27 the next survey became due 8.28, but they now reply stating they wish to discontinue the class on the boiler.

IT IS SUBMITTED that the Bilbao Surveyors be requested to take the earliest convenient opportunity of calling on the Owners, explaining the position and endeavouring to arrange for the necessary survey to be held, and the Owners might be advised accordingly.
