We refer you to your letter of the 17th May and to previous correspondence connected with this steamer and we now confirm our telephone conversation of yesterday in which we advised you that the steamer had been sold and was to be transferred to the Italian Flag before sailing from Barry.

The Owner, Mr. Galanti, has made arrangements for the steamer to be dry docked at Barry and he has also arranged for his Representative to call at 71, Fenchurch Street on Monday, the 18th July, to ascertain what the Committee will require to enable the steamer to proceed to an Italian Port where it will be transferred to Registro Italiano Classification.

As the steamer is to be transferred to the Italian Flag before leaving, we shall be glad to learn what action should be taken in regard to the Load Line Certificate.
