The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/52.)

This ship was built in 1905-12 and then classed ~~LOOAL~~.

The COPENHAGEN Surveyors recommended in their Rpt.No. 13243 of 10.50 that in view of the general condition as then found, the Special Survey due 8.51 should be carried out on the due date of which the Owners were informed 1.12.50.

There is an Endorsement (B).

The ship has since been sold to Italian Owners whose request for postponement of Special Survey until December remains to be approved - See Mr. Jordan's memo of 16.6.51.

The COPENHAGEN Surveyors report (6.51), ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated, and a Comprehensive General Examination carried out with a view to postponement of Special Survey until 12.51 which they recommend "provided the ship's service from the end of September to December (winter months) be confined to the Mediterranean". This is confirmed by the Surveyors in a letter dated 20.6.51.

The indents in stem and side shell plating, noted as an Endorsement (B), specially examined and found efficient.

IT IS SUBMITTED this ship is worthy to remain as classed, with record of docking 6.51, and Endorsement (B).
