It is submitted the Surveyors be informed, in reply to their letter of 19.8.58, it is noted that it is Auckland Island and not Auckland N.Z. that is referred to in their letter of 26.6.58.

They should be informed that the ship's arrangements and scantlings have now been examined in relation to this wider service and it has been agreed that the ship would be suitable for service between the South Pacific Islands and Auckland Island provided:

1. The freeing port area in the bulwarks aft of the bridge is increased to 5 sq. ft. on each side.
2. A winter mark is cut 2" below the summer mark.

The Surveyors should inform this office to which port the vessel will be towed so that arrangements may be made for having the ship examined and the load line certificates handed over.
