Referring to London letter dated 6th. inst. regarding first entry report of above vessel, I beg to say that the rivets through frames and shell are spaced 6" dia. apart as required by the Rules in way of 27" frame spacing, the double bottom in way of engines and boilers is watertight and has been tested as required by the Rules.
