With reference to the Glasgow first entry report No. 38244 on the S.S. "WAR CLYDE", I have to say that it is concluded that the rivets through frames and shell are spaced 6 diameter apart in way of the 27" frame spacing and elsewhere as required by the rules, but I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors, and let me know whether this is so, and also whether the double bottom in way of Engines and Boilers is watertight and has been tested as required by the rules.
