I shall be glad if you will confirm the diameter of the screwshaft fitted and stated as 275 m/m on the above report.

Attention is drawn to the Secretary's letter dated 27. 11. 56 (Ref. ENG) in which you were advised that, for the notation "Strengthened for Navigation in Ice" the screwshaft would require to be 277 m/m.

It is noticed on your report that Class is recommended subject to a torsional endorsement. This should not have been done without authority as no torsional condition is required for classification purposes.

I shall be glad to receive a reply to the above questions at the earliest possible date.
