

This is a similar ship to the Burntisland S.B. Co's Yard No.257. Plans submitted by the Burntisland Co. were dealt with in the Glasgow Office on the 31st January, 1944, and subsequent dates, for the class 100A1 with a freeboard corresponding to a summer moulded draught of 16'7½".

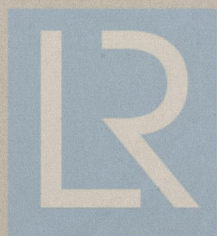
The Builders' attention was drawn to the recommendations as set forth in the Rules for the additional strengthening of the bottom if it is desired to load or discharge cargo while the vessel is lying on the ground.
