POOP ACCOMMODATION.

The Poop Companionway Deckhouse has now been rebuilt to suit new accommodation 12'-0" x 10'-0" x 6'-8" high. Fitted with strong teak door with 18" sill. ✓

POOP FRONT. Steel doors P+S, access to W.C. compartments now removed and openings plated over. ✓

2 Poop Front escape scuttles (was emergency) removed and openings fitted with spigot plates. ✓

The W.C. compartment in Poop Front P+S now deleted, storm valves removed off shell and spigot plates fitted. New W.C. swash basin discharges from Poop Companionway deckhouse P+S, discharge above freeboard deck in Poop with storm valves on shell. ✓

The Trimming Hatch P+S on Bridge Deck now removed and openings plated to suit accommodation modifications. ✓

A small steel access hatch to tween decks fitted P+S abreast Fiddley 21' x 21' x 18' x 7/8 high with w/t. steel cover. ✓
