m.v. "Marie Louise" (ex "Metrans")

We are acting on behalf of the owners of the above vessel and should be obliged if you would kindly assist us. We enclose a letter of authority dated 4th July addressed to you and signed by the vessel's managers.

The matter with which we are concerned is a claim for damage to cargo which arose from a leak which developed in this vessel whilst she was in London in early October 1956. She subsequently proceeded to Holland where the vessel was dry-docked.

We are anxious to ascertain when the vessel last passed her special survey prior to October 1956. At that time presumably the vessel will have been thoroughly inspected, and in particular will have been in drydock and her bottom plates will have been drilled and the rivets, etc. inspected for corrosion. We should like to have a copy of your surveyor's report covering the special survey.

We should also like to have particulars of all subsequent drydockings and inspections, and of any work which may have been carried out on these occasions.

We shall be grateful for your assistance.
