With reference to your letter dated the 21st instant concerning the above, I have to advise you that this vessel was boarded on the 22nd instant after receipt of a letter from the Suez Surveyors which stated that the outstanding surveys might be carried out at this Port.

As a result of this enquiry it was then stated that the vessel would be leaving Aden on that same day calling at Berbera for cargo before proceeding to Suez where the outstanding surveys would be carried out. The Suez Surveyors were therefore advised accordingly.

On further enquiry at Aden it has been ascertained that no arrangements have so far been made to drydock this vessel at this Port and that the present docking programme is indeed completely booked up until well into the New Year.


