The writer should be informed that all these ships were previously classed with this Society +100 A1 "Strengthened for navigation in ice" and the scantlings would therefore be suitable for the service indicated.

If the ship is to be reclassified a special survey in accordance with the Rules, for re-classification, would be required.

The Board of Trade would be responsible for the issue of any necessary passenger certificate, if the ship is to be British registered.
