

Dear Sir,

I refer to my telephone conversation of today with Mr. Kershaw of your Ships Research Department, regarding possible use of a steam vessel, now in the Newfoundland Coast Service, in the United Kingdom waters for passenger cruises by an organisation of a charitable nature which may be formed. The service would be in open waters anywhere around the British Isles and nearby Atlantic Coast of Europe.

Several vessels in the Newfoundland service seem, by their characteristics, to be suitable for the purpose envisaged and it is projected that I go to Newfoundland, starting in about ten days time, to investigate the matter with the owners and see the ships.

I write this to ask if you would be kind enough to study your records to see whether or not you feel it could be a feasible project to put any one of these vessels in ^{the} service intended. It is contemplated to carry out the repair and renewal of hull, machinery, piping, electrical, etc. equipment in order to fit the vessel for service and also to assure preservation as an example of a type of ship of some historic interest.
