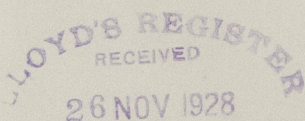

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd. instant in regard to Glasgow First Entry Report No. 48624 on the new steamer "PRINCESS NORAH" and to enclose herewith a letter from Mr. Nicol on the subject.
