ALEXANDER".

The steam drums, sectional headers, mud drums and water walls were built under this Society's Special Survey and to approved plans, also to the U.S. Coast Guard requirements.

The results of tests of specimens of fusion welded joints, X-ray examinations and hydraulic tests were found satisfactory.
