I am in receipt of your letter of the 13th instant regarding the indented shell plating referred to in the Special Reason List No.174 (port side poop). This was re-examined at the recent Special Survey, and it was then found that the temporary repair previously effected in 1956 to be now considered efficient, and not prejudicial to the maintenance of Class.

In the circumstances, I recommend that this blemish should in future appear only in the Appendix to the Special Reasons List, and not form a subject of Class.




