the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Admiralty, survey during construction, the hull of the R.F.A. "EDDYBEACH", Yard No. 474, built by Messrs. Caledon Shipbuilding and Engineering Co. Ltd., Dundee.

This ship has been built under Special Survey in conformity with the Society Rules and Regulations. The scantlings and arrangements of the ship are as shown and amended on the approved plans. All modifications made during construction have been approved as being in accordance with, or by standards equivalent to, the Rule Requirements.

The workmanship and materials are good.

The Double Bottom Tanks, Cofferdams, Deep Tanks, Fore and Aft Peaks, W.T. Bulkheads, Decks, W.T. Hatches, W.T. Doors, Hand Pumps, Bilge Suctions, Windlass and Steering Gear have been tested in accordance with the Rules with satisfactory results.

The Domestic Refrigerated Spaces and Cargo Piping have been examined during construction on behalf of the Admiralty.

The vessel will be recommended to be classed "100A1" "carrying petroleum in bulk" with the notation "Longitudinal Framing at Bottom and Deck". A special notation will be made in the Register Book regarding electric welding.
