H. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamers "OCHTA" and "OKA" and the Motorship "ENUKIDSE", and to letters which have been addressed to you from this Office regarding overdue survey matters to which no reply appears to have been received, I beg to acquaint you that these cases have received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today.

In the circumstances the Committee have deferred the further consideration of these cases for one month, but I am directed to inform you that in the absence of a reply to this letter within that time, the Committee will have no option but to expunge the classes of the vessels from the Register Book with a Red Line in each case, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
