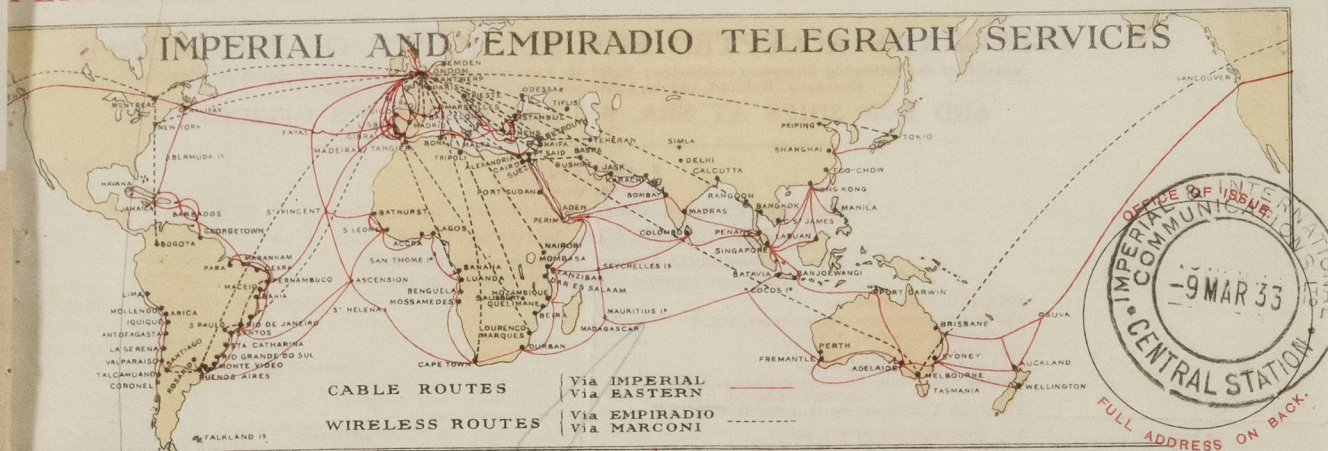

It is also received at all Postal Telegraph Offices, but should be marked "VIA EASTERN" or "VIA IMPERIAL" if intended for transmission by cable, or "VIA MACEONI" or "VIA EMPHADIO" if intended for transmission by wireless. This indication is not charged.
