Steamer "ANTHAS" - ex "MAKEDONIA"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 30th May, the contents of which have been noted.

Information has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus to the effect that the new Owners of this ship intend to transfer the class to the American Bureau. The case received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today when instructions were given for the notation "Class Withdrawn" to be entered against the ship's name in the Society's Register Book.

The Classification position is as follows:

- Special Survey due December, 1961.
- Engine Survey due December, 1961.
- Boiler Survey due April, 1962.
- Screwshaft Survey due October, 1963.
- Steam Pipe Survey due October, 1966.
- Ship last examined in drydock October, 1960.

The class of this ship was subject to indented shell plates in sheerstrake, first and second strakes below sheer in way of engine and boiler spaces, port side, being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking.
