The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The 2nd Special Survey No. 2, due 4.39, has been partly held, and a proposal to advance it and if possible complete the Survey on the vessel's return to Trieste or Genoa, has been agreed to.

The Genoa Surveyors now report the Special Survey advanced afloat.

To complete the Survey the forward cofferdam, and double bottom tanks Nos. 4 and 5, require to be examined internally.

The wing divisions of the oil fuel bunkers, which were previously examined for Special Survey, have now again been examined internally, and found in order.

It is submitted action be deferred.
