Steamer "CANADIAN OBSERVER".

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, with its enclosure, the contents of which have been noted.

Provided you concur, it is suggested that the second and third paragraphs of your proposed letter to Messrs. Beauregard, Bisset & Reycroft might be amended as follows:-

" In reply we have to inform you that from records in this Office this ship went through Special Survey at Montreal 9, 53, and subsequently through drydocking surveys at Montreal 8, 54, St. John's N.B. 6, 55 and Lauzon P.Q. 8, 56.

At the Special Survey 9, 53 and drydocking survey 6, 55 the Surveyors reported all bilges cleaned, examined and coated and all double bottom tanks tested.

At the drydocking survey at Lauzon 8, 56 the fore and after holds were examined and all parts surveyed, found or placed in good condition. No specific reference in this case has been made to indicate that this examination included the bilges.

I trust this furnishes the information you desire.
