FOR SHIP AND/OR ENGINEER SURVEYORS

A complete Main Boiler Survey was held at Piraeus in June 1962 and since then defects have occurred in both boilers (Aden Report 3408 and Suez Report 1742).

The port boiler was examined at Piraeus in January 1963 when recommendations were made for de-scaling and the renewal of 50 tubes. Under pressure test several tubes were noted as being leaking.

Recommendations were also made regarding deficient fire extinguishing arrangements.

The ship left Piraeus without any of the above recommendations receiving attention, and on 14th February the Principal Surveyor at Piraeus was requested to inform the Owners that a notation of "Repairs required class suspended 2.63" had been assigned; further that a Special Survey due in March 1963 required to be taken in hand forthwith, *and class would be withdrawn altogether*

The vessel also required to be specially examined as a result of a reported grounding.

On 4th March the Owners' Agent informed the Principal Surveyor, Piraeus, the ship was loading in the Black Sea and that she would proceed to Naples and thence to Piraeus when a full Special Survey would be held about April.

The Surveyor has since been unable to obtain any information regarding the Owners' intentions.
