I have to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them Montreal Report No.5644 on the steamer "FORT TADOUSSAC" which vessel has been classed "100A1 With Freeboard".

I am directed, however, to inform you that it is considered wherever possible in sister vessels 3/16" face plates on the 12" channel frames forward of the half length amidships, should be of greater thickness and reduced width and not less sectional area, and I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly.
