We have to acknowledge the receipt of Classing Letter, dated the 28th ultimo, respecting the above.

In reply thereto we wish to advise that the Quebec Surveyor states that the double bottom tanks under the boilers are dry tanks, but were hydrostatically tested in accordance with the Society's Rules for the testing of D. B. Ballast Tanks.

He concurs that the heads of the Stockless Anchors are not less than $\frac{3}{5}$ the total weight of the Anchor, as tabulated below;-

<u>Total Weight</u>	<u>Head</u>
5260 lbs.	3316 lbs. $\frac{3}{5}$ = 3156 lbs.
5210 lbs.	3300 lbs. $\frac{3}{5}$ = 3126 lbs.
1638 lbs.	1028 lbs. $\frac{3}{5}$ = 981 lbs.

We enclose herewith Certificates covering the Intermediate and Screwshifting, and regret that these were inadvertently omitted from the First Entry Report.
