

The Special Survey No.3 of this vessel became due and in August, 1929, the Genoa Surveyors were requested to inform the (late) Owners that the Committee could not agree to their proposal to postpone this survey until that of the Registro Italiano (with whom the vessel is also classed) became due, viz: in February, 1932.

In July last the Genoa Surveyors were asked to inform the Owners that action would be deferred on the definite understanding that the requirements of the Special Survey No.3 would be carried out when the vessel next drydocked before the end of the summer.

The Genoa Surveyors now write that the vessel has been sold and forward a copy of a letter from the new Owners in which they ask to renounce the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book. The year of grace expired 8,30.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 31st ultimo, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
