With reference to your Steamer "MARY BIRCH" now named "CESARE" I have to point out the desirability of obtaining fresh freeboard certificates made out in the new name.

For this purpose it will be necessary for the freeboard marks on the vessel's sides to be verified by the Society's Surveyors and if you will be so good as to let me know when and at what port it will be convenient for you to have this done the Society's Surveyors will be instructed accordingly, or if the vessel should arrive at your port, perhaps you will call in the Society's local Surveyors.
