With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the ferro-concrete vessel "CRETECOVE", which is understood to have recently become your property, I am directed to acquaint you that a report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle, from which it appears that the vessel has been placed in dry dock and some damage repaired as necessary.

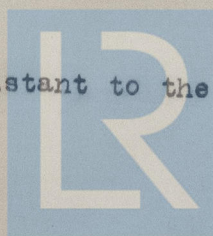
The vessel is reported to have left the Tyne for Brevik, and I have to point out that this port is outside the limited area for which she is classed in the Society's Register Book.
