The Society's Surveyor at Kingston, Jamaica, has reported that the boiler of this ship was examined under steam in January last when the safety valves were adjusted. This completes the Boiler Survey, which was commenced in August, 1957, and a notation of Boiler Survey 8,57 has now been assigned.

In view of this survey, and having regard to your letter of the 1st November, 1957, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether there has been any change in the circumstances in this case.

In the meantime the class of the ship continues to be qualified with the notation of "Laid up - Surveys Overdue".
