"M.M.S. 1047" & "M.M.S. 1084"

I have to acquaint you that Messrs. Phillips, Anderson & Co., Ltd., have requested to be supplied with certificates immediately the classification surveys of these vessels are completed, for handing to U.N.R.R.A. I shall be glad therefore if you will arrange to issue Interim Certificates giving your class recommendations in respect of the "M.M.S. 1084" to the local agents of Messrs. Phillips, Anderson as soon as the survey of the machinery is completed. Your report 9 should be forwarded to this Office without delay.

Mr. Robertson should similarly prepare an Interim Certificate B for the hull of the "M.M.S. 1047" and forward the original to Mr. Collinson at Torquay for issue when his machinery survey is completed. Mr. Collinson is being advised accordingly. Copies of the Interim Certificates issued should be forwarded to this Office for record purposes.

With regard to the "M.M.S. 1084" I may say it is concluded adequate ventilation has been provided in way of the oil fuel tanks, but I shall be glad if you will confirm this, and at the same time furnish the length of the forecastle in accordance with Circular No. 1551, and the extreme breadth over belting if fitted.
